#### JOINT ADVISORY NOTICE FROM EAST SPRING PRIMARY SCHOOL AND LAND TRANSPORT AUTHORITY (LTA)

The Land Transport Authority (LTA) and our school has received numerous feedback from the local community, including fellow parents, regarding vehicles parking or waiting indiscriminately along *Tampines Street 33* before/after school dismissal hours.

We wish to remind parents and guardians that LTA will not allow any vehicles to wait/park along the mentioned roads. We are collaborating closely with LTA to ensure the safety of the children and other road users.

While we understand the need of parents/guardians having to pick up their children, such inconsiderate parking causes inconveniences, obstruction to traffic and safety issues. This had also caused a service disruption to our buses plying along *Tampines Street 33*.

These inconsiderate and dangerous acts have posed safety concerns to all road users. The authorities <u>will</u> <u>not hesitate to take enforcement actions</u> against errant road users who flout traffic rules and regulations. Offenders are liable to face the following penalties:

To prevent further traffic congestion and crowding outside the school gates, any waiting/illegal parking along the highlighted roads along *Tampines Street 33* during school days, <u>will be subjected to enforcement actions</u>. Early arrival and parking indiscriminately will cause inconvenience, obstruction, and danger to other road users. Members of the public (inclusive of schools or parents) may take

photographs of the offending vehicle and submit to LTA for processing of such violations. LTA will also continue to deploy warden, and errant motorists may be subjected to enforcement actions.



To address these concerns, we seek the cooperation of parents/guardians to arrive at the destination only when you are ready to perform the immediate pick-up. In the event that you arrive early, please make use of the designated carparks. (Refer to map)

Thank you for your understanding. Let's be considerate and mindful on the safety of all road users. Together, we will make the roads safer, and your continued cooperation is much appreciated.
